Day by Day Itinerary

Saturday, July 22 – Omaha/Portland



Fly this morning from Omaha to Portland (arriving around 11:00 a.m. PDT) where your tour director and chartered private motor coach are awaiting your arrival at Portland International Airport. Stop for lunch

on your own before beginning your sightseeing and guided tour of the handsome “City of Roses,” acquainting us with such sights as Lloyd Center, the sparkling downtown area on the Willamette River, the Portlandia statue, Portland Center for the Performing Arts, the Old Town Historic District, and famed Portland Saturday Market. In Washington Park, we’ll experience a panorama of the city and the surrounding mountains, then visit the renowned International Rose Test Gardens, where 10,000 rose bushes represent some 500 varieties. After checking in for a two-night stay at the Shilo Inn & Suites, we’ll head for a fun-filled “welcome” dinner at Der Rheinlander German Restaurant. **(D)**

Sunday, July 23 – Columbia River Gorge

Today we’ll embark on a full-day “circle” tour, beginning on the historic Columbia River Highway through the beautiful Columbia River Gorge, where sheer cliffs rise as high as 2,000 feet. Along the way, we’ll stop at the Vista House at Crown Point, affording spectacular gorge views, visit splendid Multnomah Falls, the fourth tallest in the U.S., and explore mammoth Bonneville Lock and Dam, where salmon can be viewed through large windows as they swim upstream to spawn. After an included lunch at the historic Columbia Gorge Hotel overlooking the river, this afternoon we’ll travel through the splendid orchards and vineyards of the Hood River Valley, then climb the slopes of towering Mount Hood to make a stop at the historic Timberline Lodge, a living museum of arts and crafts built during the 1930’s as a W.P.A project. We’ll return to Portland early this evening and enjoy dinner on your own. **(B, L)**

Monday, July 24 – Explore the Oregon Coast



Check-out and motor west from Portland to begin your journey along the magnificent Oregon Coast, viewing beaches, sheer cliffs and pounding surf as you travel through Tillamook, Pacific City and Lincoln City. We’ll pause

en route to tour the fascinating Tillamook Cheese Factory with an opportunity for lunch and a little shopping on your own, take the breathtaking Three Capes Scenic Drive, and



visit the unique Otter Crest Scenic Viewpoint, perched high above the Pacific at Otter Rock, as well as the adjacent Devil’s Punchbowl. A stop will also be made at the Yaquina Head Outstanding Natural Area, home of the 1873 Yaquina Head Lighthouse, the state’s tallest. Oceanfront accommodations at the Shilo Inn Suites have been arranged tonight in Newport and after dinner at the hotel, you’re sure to enjoy a sunset stroll, as well as a bonfire and marshmallow roast on the beach. **(B, D)**

Tuesday, July 25 – Oregon Dunes

Continuing our coastal adventure through Yachats, Florence,

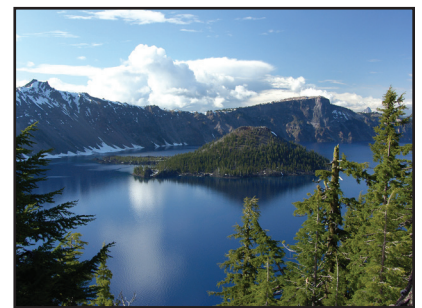


Reedsburg, North Bend and Coos Bay, numerous state parks attest to the popularity of the region as a vacation paradise. Today’s sightseeing highlights begin with a morning visit to magnificent Cape Perpetua, the highest point

on the Oregon Coast, to view tidal pools, the narrow channel that is aptly named Devil’s Churn, a fascinating “blow hole” and pristine beaches pounded by the ocean surf. Then, traveling by four-wheel-drive vehicle, we’ll explore the fabulous 250-foot sand dunes at Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area, enjoy a picnic lunch, plus make a visit to the lovely botanical gardens of Shore Acres State Park. Heading inland, this evening we’ll begin a two-night stay at the Shilo Inn, Grants Pass. **(B, L)**

Wednesday, July 26 – Crater Lake National Park

This day will be spent discovering the natural wonders of Crater Lake National Park. More than 6,800 years ago, following climactic eruptions, the volcano once located here collapsed and formed a deep basin. Rain and



snow filled the empty caldera to a depth of 1,932 feet, making the brilliant blue waters of the crater into the deepest lake in North America. We’ll follow the 35-mile Rim Drive for unmatched panoramic views of the lake, surrounded by mountain peaks and forest lands. Later we’ll make stops to view the waters rushing through the scenic Rogue River Gorge and visit the historic Union Creek Resort nearby, plus have dinner in picturesque Jacksonville on the return trip to Grant’s Pass. **(B, D)**

Thursday, July 27 – JetBoat Trip and Redwood National Park

A special treat this morning is our two-hour, 36-mile jetboat excursion down the Rogue River and through the spectacular Hellgate Canyon wilderness area, where sheer rock walls rise over 250 feet. Then, entering California, our travels take us into the domain of the skyscraping



coastal redwoods. Here are splendid state parklands... Jedediah Smith, Del Norte Coast, and Prairie Creek Redwoods State Parks...as well as the fine groves of Redwood National Park. Following the rocky coastline through miles of giant forests, today's destination is Eureka, where overnight accommodations await at the Red Lion. Our dinner this evening features the plentiful, lumberjack camp-style cooking of the historic Samoa Cookhouse. **(B, D)**

Friday, July 28 – Avenue of the Giants and Wine - Tasting

Another of our tour highlights is this morning's drive along the "Avenue of the Giants," past huge stands of magnificent redwoods and through both Humboldt Redwoods and Richardson Grove State Parks. This afternoon we'll motor through the famed Sonoma Valley wine country, filled with picturesque wineries and lush green vineyards ripening their fruit in the valley's ideal climate. A stop has been scheduled here for tasting and to learn the time-honored tradition of producing fine champagne at the Korbel Champagne Cellars in Guerneville. Reaching San Francisco, we'll cross the storied Golden Gate Bridge and check-in for a two-night stay in the heart of the city at the Holiday Inn Civic Center. This evening we're sure to enjoy a delicious Chinese banquet dinner in colorful Chinatown. **(B, D)**

Saturday, July 29 – San Francisco and Bay Cruise

We'll spend the morning touring San Francisco, discovering the many sights for which the "City by the Bay" is renowned...Chinatown, Union Square, the Civic Center, Mission Dolores, Golden Gate Park, Lombard Street, Nob Hill, The Presidio, and many more. Our afternoon



begins at the Fisherman's Wharf area, where there will be time for browsing the unique shops here, plus nearby Pier 39, The Cannery, Ghirardelli Square, and San Francisco Maritime National Historic Park. Next is an invigorating cruise on the bay, passing Alcatraz Island and the Golden Gate Bridge while offering panoramic views of the city skyline. Our "farewell" dinner overlooking the harbor from Pier 39 completes the day in style. **(B, D)**

Sunday, July 30 – San Francisco/Omaha

Completing a memorable vacation, after breakfast we'll pause to take a ride on one of the city's storied cable cars, then transfer to either San Francisco International Airport (around 11:00 a.m. PDT) to catch our Omaha-bound flight. **(B)**
