ITINERARY

August 17 - Pre-Departure

A block of rooms has been reserved for our group at the Drury Inn & Suites in West Des Moines, IA for \$129 plus tax if you'd prefer to stay the night prior to departure. August 18 - Depart West Des Moines / Overnight flight en route

Meet us this morning at the Drury Inn & Suites in West Des Moines, IA (approximately 7:00 a.m.) where we make our way to Chicago's O'Hare International Airport via deluxe motorcoach and our nonstop overnight flight to Dublin, Ireland!

August 19 - Arrive in Dublin / Blarney Castle & Stone

Cead mile failte! (The Irish Gaelic term meaning "a hundred thousand welcomes!") Shortly after "touchdown" at Dublin Airport, we meet our local tour guide/driver who will welcome us to Ireland! Relax and get to know your fellow travelers on our drive to Blarney. Blarney is world-renowned for being the site of the Blarney Castle and famed "Stone of Eloquence," where you'll get to climb its battlements and kiss the stone. From Blarney, journey through the rugged countryside to Killarney where we'll check-in for our twonight stay and enjoy a welcome dinner together. **(D)**

August 20 - Ring of Kerry

Today, set off to explore the Ring of Kerry, which consists of over 100 miles of marvelous scenery. See some of Ireland's highest peaks on one side of the road and a coastline scattered with golden beaches and rocky headlands on the other. We'll pause at strategic locations along the way to admire the views and take the best photos. Next, visit a local farm, where you will have the opportunity to meet an Irish farmer and to see some sheepdogs work in their natural environment. This evening we return back to Killarney for a free evening to enjoy this welcoming Irish town on our own. **(B)**

August 21 - Cliffs of Moher

This morning we leave Killarney to Tarbert, where we take a short ferry ride across the River Shannon Estuary. Next, drive along the coast of County Clare to visit the Cliffs of Moher, which overlooks the shimmering Atlantic Ocean. Harry Potter and the Half Blood Prince along with the Princess Bride feature scenes that were filmed at this stunning landmark. Continue to the lively city of Limerick, where we'll be overnight, and spend some time to relax or freshen up before tonight's festivities! This evening, join in the fun and feasting at Bunratty or Knappogue Castle! Your medievalstyle banquet is served in the Great Hall of the 15th century castle. **(B, D)**

August 22 - Galway / Dublin

Today we meet a local guide for a gentle walking tour of Galway. See the medieval city walls, Lynch's Castle and its narrow streets. Then we leave Galway and travel across Ireland's rolling pastures to the greater metropolitan area of Dublin. Here we check-in for our three-night stay in Dublin where you can enjoy the rest of the day at your leisure to sight-see and have dinner on your own at one of the areas many terrific restaurants. Tonight is also the perfect night to make your last predictions for tomorrow's football game over a drink at a local pub as tomorrow is game day! **(B)**

August 23 – Iowa State vs. Kansas State Football at Aviva Stadium

Today is game day! Today we make our way to nearby Aviva Stadium to cheer on the Cyclones or Wildcats as they kick-off their 2025 college football season! With a capacity of just over 47,000, Aviva Stadium opened in 2010 and is host to many international sporting events such as soccer and rugby as well as a venue for large concerts. Take your seats to what is hoped to be an epic match between these Big 12 rivals! This will be lowa State's first international football game and Kansas State's first game outside the United States since they played Nebraska in Tokyo, Japan back in 1992 – and you'll get to experience it LIVE! After the game you are free to enjoy the rest of the evening at your leisure, hopefully celebrating your teams victory! **(B)**

August 24 - Dublin

After breakfast, set off with a local guide who will show you around Dublin. The city has been molded through the centuries by economic, political and artistic influences that has shaped its architecture. Stop to tour Guinness Storehouse to see exhibits on how this world-famous stout was first created and why it is so popular today. Finish your visit in the roof-top bar, where you can sample a draft of Guinness. Then, continue on to visit the EPIC Ireland, which celebrates the dramatic story of the spread of Irish culture around the globe, and how Ireland has changed throughout the years. Return to your nearby accommodations and spend the rest of the day at leisure to make one last Irish memory! **(B)**

August 25 - Return Home

Transfer to Dublin Airport for our return flight back to the United States. Round trip airfare will be requested on a late afternoon nonstop flight out of Chicago O'Hare to Dublin. Transportation to Chicago O'Hare from West Des Moines will be by deluxe motorcoach. Moostash Joe Tours must receive a copy of the information (photo) page of your passport by the final payment due date and is recommended that your passport be valid for at least six months from the return date of your tour. After final payment, any changes to your reservation will incur a change fee of up to \$200 per person. Moostash Joe Tours is unable to issue copies of airline tickets for passengers requesting to use frequent flyer miles. Seats for your flight are assigned at the airport gate. Seat upgrades are available upon request for an additional fee, based on availability and are not available to be requested until 60 days prior to departure, and on the terms of each individual airline carrier. Baggage fees will be the responsibility of the passenger and depend on each individual airline carrier. Due to the group size, we are unable to accommodate pre and post touring in Ireland. Flight information will be available approximately one month prior to departure and will be sent with your final travel documents.

Football Game Ticket Policy

• Tickets will be requested from the official travel partner of the 2025 Aer Lingus College Football Classic. In the event they do not fulfill our entire request, tickets are obtained from ticket agencies and could be located in any part of the stadium, including upper-end zones. Every attempt will be made to secure tickets in one section of the stadium for our group, however, tickets may be in pairs or in groups of fours.
