ITINERARY

November 12 - Travel Day / Elkhart, IN

Meet your Moostash Joe Tour Director and Driver at one of our many convenient pick-up points this morning and head east! Our travels take us through Iowa, Illinois and to Elkhart, IN where we'll be overnight.

November 13 - Harrisburg, PA

Today, continue east through Ohio and the beautiful Pennsylvania countryside to Harrisburg, PA, where we'll also enjoy an evening meal together. **(B, D)**

November 14 - Pennsylvania Amish Country / Philadelphia, PA

This morning we take the short drive to Lancaster, PA and the Mennonite Information Center. Here we meet our local stepon guide, of Mennonite or Amish heritage, for a guided tour of Pennsylvania Amish Country. Lancaster County is known for its abundance of Mennonite and Amish as well as being the home of the oldest existing Amish settlement in the world! After our tour we enjoy a delicious authentic Pennsylvania Dutch lunch at the Birdin-Hand Family Restaurant & Smorgasbord. This afternoon finds us in Philadelphia to meet our local step-on guide for a guided city tour of the city commonly known as "The City of Brotherly Love." Later this evening, our day ends in Lyndhurst, NJ for our five-night stay just outside of New York City. **(B, L, D)**

November 15 - NYC Touring / Broadway Show

Good morning and welcome to the "Big Apple!" A day full of fun activities await! We'll meet our local step-on guide as we make our way around Manhattan, making our first stop for our Backstage Tour at the famed Lincoln Center for the Performing Arts – home to New York's most prominent performing groups. We'll enjoy lunch together before an afternoon visiting Central Park, Rockefeller Center, St. Patrick's Cathedral and ending up in Times Square. This evening you'll have time to enjoy the bright lights and one of New York's fabulous restaurants on your own before our Broadway Show, Wicked at the Gershwin Theatre! **(B, L)**

November 16 - NYC Touring

Back in the city, our morning includes a visit to the acclaimed Metropolitan Museum or Art. Also known as "the Met", it is the largest art museum in the United States and third most visited in the world. After lunch together, we continue our sightseeing in NYC at Grand Central Terminal, the United Nations to Harlem and concluding with free time at Macy's, one of the largest stores in the world – covering an entire city block. **(B, L)**

November 17 - NYC Touring / Broadway Show

Another full day in New York City starts out with a driving tour through Greenwich Village and SoHo.
